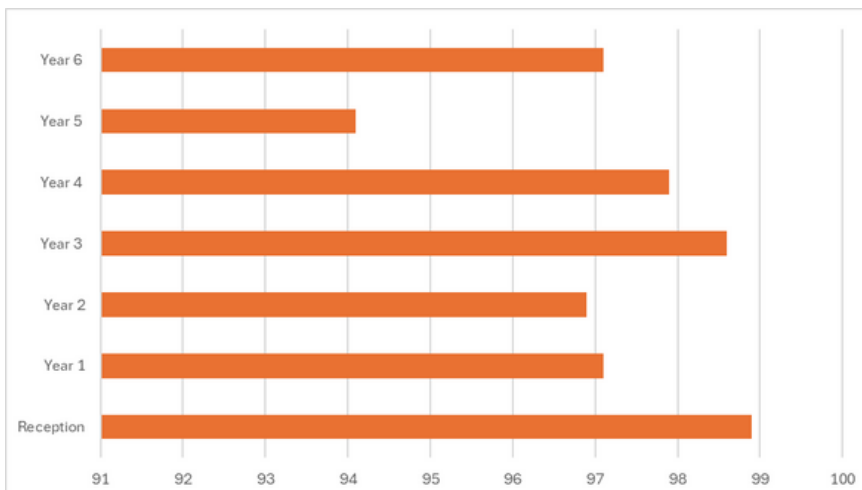


ATTENDANCE

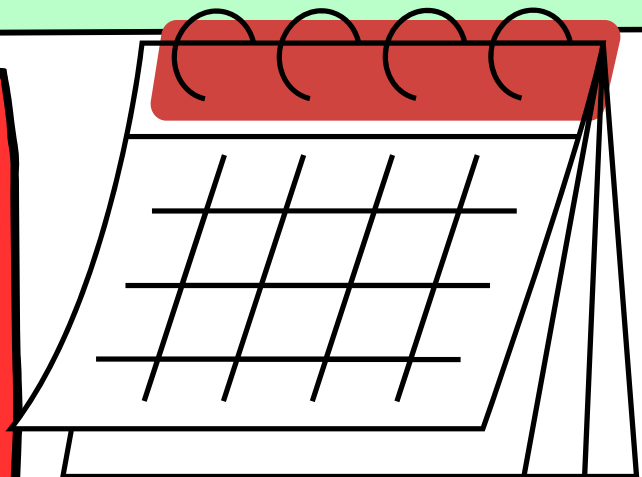


PARENTS EVENING

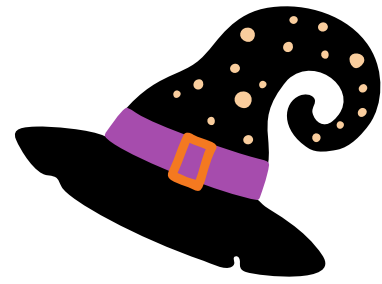

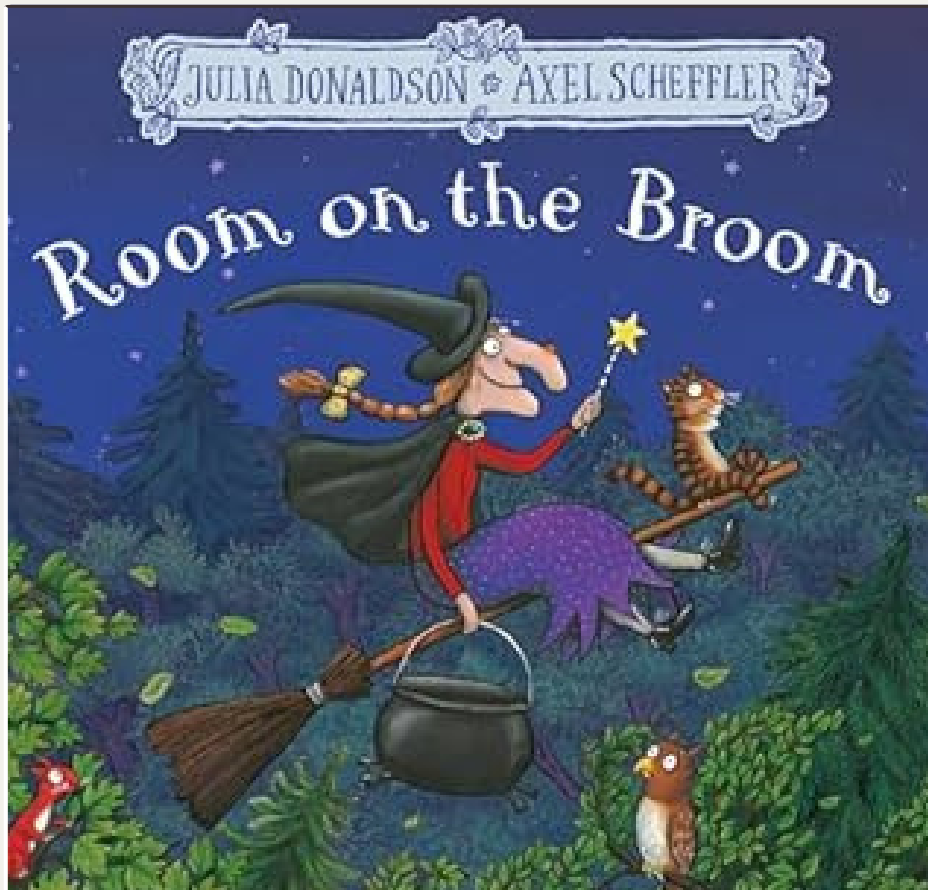
