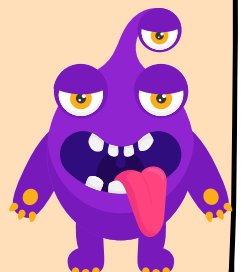

Our PTA is organising Roscoe Primary's Monster Mash Disco, details are below -

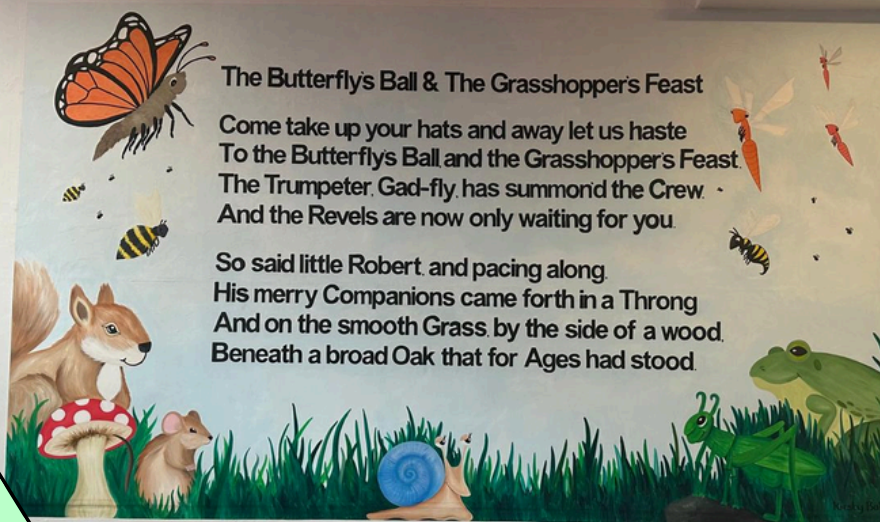
Wednesday 23rd October

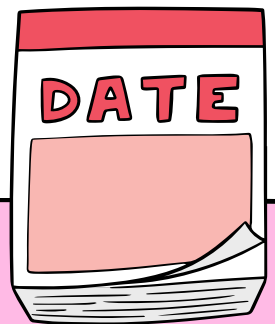
