UPDATE YOU NEXT WEEK.




ATTENDANCE


WORLD BOOK DAY

Dear Parents/Carers,

On <u>Thursday 6th March</u>, It is our favourite day of the year: World Book Day! This year we would like to invite children to dress up as their favourite book character. We are also encouraging children to come into school with their favourite book.

Children will take part in lots of activities during the school day and of course our famous Roscoe World Book Day Catwalk! In addition, we will be hosting a 'Roscoe Book Swap'. We are asking for each child to choose a book that they have read and loved and swap it for a new book from another child! Please help your child to wrap their book in paper (any type of paper to disguise the look of the book – even Christmas paper!). They should then attach a note or tag with clues about the book e.g. This book is perfect for someone who likes mystery stories!

Every child will come home with a new World Book Day book and a Roscoe Book Swap book.

Please make sure your book is suitable for your child's year group as they will be swapped within their class.
