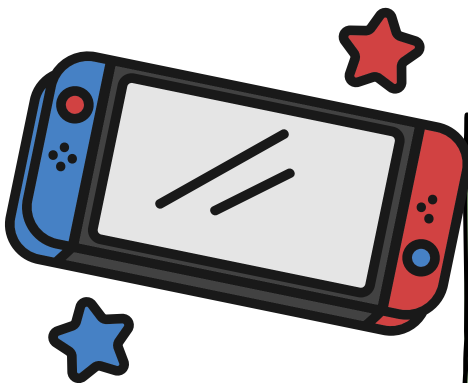
Dear Parents & Carers,

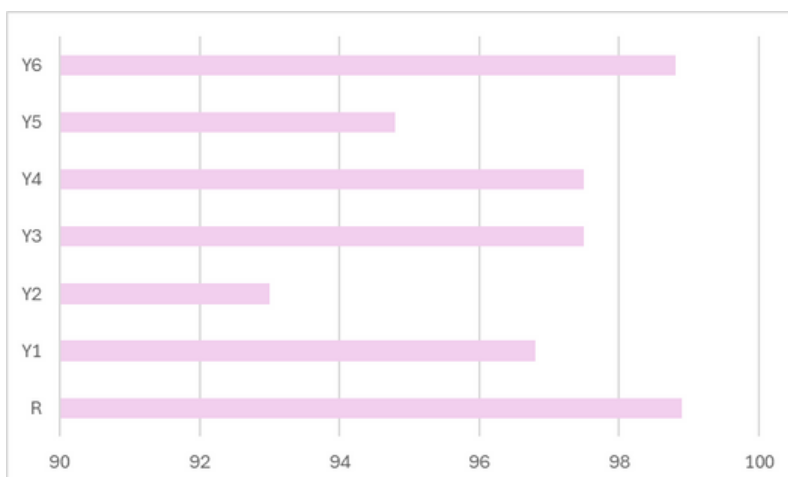


ATTENDANCE
